

Detroit Lakes, Minnesota

June 23, 2015

The Special Meeting of the City Council was called to order in the Council Chambers of the City of Detroit Lakes Administration Building, June 23, 2015 at 5:00 P.M., all members of the City Council having been notified of the meeting and the business to be transacted.

Present: Mayor Matt Brenk; City Administrator Robert Louiseau; City Clerk Glori French; Finance Officer Pam Slifka; Public Works Director Brad Green, Public Utility General Manager Vernell Roberts, City Attorney Charlie Ramstad and Intern Dylan Ramstad Skoyles

Aldermen: Imholte, Marks Erickson, Schiller, Schurman, Sukke, Waller, Wenner and Zeman

Absent: None

Mayor Brenk opened the meeting noting that the Special Council Meeting discussion would be limited only to the agenda items.

Mayor Brenk announced candidate TJ Buboltz, 1638 East Shore Drive, withdrew his name for consideration to the Ward II vacancy. Mayor Brenk then introduced the two remaining candidates, David E. Brainard, 115 Willow Street East and Jay Schurman, 1537 East Shore Drive. Mayor Brenk then began asking the 22 interview questions, alternating the order of the questions between the two candidates. Upon completion of the interview questions, and with no other questions, a motion was made by Alderman Imholte, seconded by Alderman Zeman and carried without a dissenting vote, to administer a paper ballot to select the candidate to fill the vacancy. City Administrator Bob Louiseau and City Clerk Gori French, tallied the ballots. Mayor Brenk announced the result of the ballots. Jay Schurman received the most votes by ballot and is appointed to the vacant Ward II Alderman position pursuant to the Council's motion.

Mayor Brenk thanked David Brainard for his time and interest in the possibility of being appointed to a City Council Advisory Committee.

There being no further business to conduct, by general consent, the Mayor adjourned the meeting 5:40 P.M.
